The Community Task Force held their initial meeting to discuss future community facilities in Liberty Lake. Committee members discussed the results from the City's recent community survey for the City Parks, Recreation, Open Space, and Trails Plan update, a municipal swimming pool, community center / library.

Members talked about potential locations for a municipal pool that included Pavillion Park, Town Square Park, Trailhead, and the Central Valley School District site. It was suggested the task force tour pools in Spokane. Other suggestions included extending the boundary to the Liberty Lake Sewer and Water District's boundary limits; seeking help from developers and home owners associations, obtaining grant funding; and fundraising efforts.

Discussions were held about "a third place". The concept being that people go to their homes and to their jobs, but they need a third place to go, such as a community center / library location. Trailhead was considered as a potential site for this facility.

It was determined more information is needed for future discussions. A city staff member will attend the next meeting to provide additional information about the community survey results. The task force also decided subsequent meetings will be held at 6:30 p.m. every first and third Thursday at City Hall, beginning June 4th through the August 7th.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
