**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON NAMING THE
MEETING SPACE AT THE TRAILHEAD CLUBHOUSE AS “ROTARY ROOM” AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, in December 2021, the City of Liberty Lake (“City”) awarded a contract to Bouten Construction to design and construct a new clubhouse for the City-owned Trailhead Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, proposed improvements to the Trailhead Clubhouse (“Clubhouse”) included the construction of a new meeting room, with capacity to seat 100 people; and

WHEREAS, in June of 2022, the Rotary Club of Liberty Lake Centennial Foundation (“Rotary”), entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City to donate \$50,000 towards the new Clubhouse, including for audio and visual equipment for the new meeting space, and design features for the entry; and

WHEREAS, Rotary requested the City officially name the meeting room in the Clubhouse as “Rotary Room”.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington as follows:

The meeting room in the Trailhead Clubhouse is hereby officially named “Rotary Room”.


This Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
