RESOLUTION NO. 23-252**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SPOKANE COUNTY BALLOT MEASURE NO. 1

WHEREAS, Measure No. 1, if approved by voters would increase sales and use tax in Spokane County by an additional two-tenths of one percent (0.2%), commencing April 1, 2024, and terminating December 31, 2054; and

WHEREAS, if approved, proceeds would be used as authorized by RCW 82.14.450 by the County and Cities and Towns within Spokane County for criminal justice, public safety, correctional infrastructure, and behavioral health purposes as provided for in Spokane County Resolution No. 22-0824; and

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake views public safety as a priority and supports efforts to improve the criminal justice system throughout Spokane County; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the limitations of existing facilities and workforces to continue handling the complex challenges associated with growing population, crime, addiction, and behavioral health numbers; and

WHEREAS, the City supports the development of criminal justice facilities that meet the region's existing and future needs, and allows law enforcement personnel to perform their jobs effectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington:

Supports Spokane County Ballot Measure No. 1 and encourages all voters in the City of Liberty Lake to cast a ballot and make an informed decision on Measure No. 1.


