**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON IN SUPPORT  
OF WASHINGTON INITIATIVE 2117**

**WHEREAS**, Washington State Initiative 2117 (“Initiative 2117”) seeks to repeal the 2021 Washington Commitment Act (“CCA”) passed by the Washington State Legislature, which provides for a cap and investment program designed to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by ninety-five percent (95%) by 2050; and

**WHEREAS**, if approved by voters, Initiative 2117 would repeal the CCA and prohibit Washington state agencies from implementing a cap and trade or cap and tax program as provided for in the CCA; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Liberty Lake believes that the CCA has increased and/or impacted gas prices in the City of Liberty Lake since the CCA took effect on January 1, 2021; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Liberty Lake recognizes the importance of economic growth and believes residents and businesses are negatively impacted by such price increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington that it hereby supports Initiative 2117 and encourages all voters in the City of Liberty Lake to cast a ballot and make an informed decision on Initiative 2117.
