

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-73
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, RELATING
TO ADMINISTRATIVE FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES AND/OR MATERIALS
PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE MUNICIPAL LIBRARY**

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to establish fees and charges for services provided; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of recovering the cost of services or materials through the imposition of fees and charges where appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain the following fees and charges shall be assessed as follows:

Section 1. Overdue Materials. A fine of \$.10 cents per day, per item, shall be assessed for overdue material(s) regardless of type. Overdue fines will not exceed the retail price of the item.


Section 2. Lost or Unusable Material. The fee for an item that is no longer useable or is lost shall be the retail price of that item plus a \$5.00 processing fee. If the item is overdue, the overdue fine will be waived in favor of the processing fee. The patron may elect to purchase an exact replacement (same or better edition) of the item and donate it to the library. Fees for damage of packaging material shall not exceed the actual replacement price of the material.

Section 3. Printing Fees. Computer generated printed material or documents shall be \$.10 cents per page for black and white; and \$.50 cents per page for color. Printing basic editions of State and Federal tax forms are free. Free printing does not apply to worksheets, booklets, or instructions on preparing the forms.

Section 4. Lost or Replaced Library Cards. A fee of \$2.00 shall be assessed for lost or replaced library cards.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Liberty Lake City Council.
