SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON,
ENDORING THE CENTRAL VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND PROPOSAL AND
ENCOURAGING THE VOTERS TO VOTE BY NOVEMBER 7, 2006.**

WHEREAS, the Liberty Lake City Council recognizes that excellent schools contribute to the quality of life in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Central Valley School District has, with the assistance of a committee comprised of parents, community members, classified and certificated staff and school board members, identified certain capital improvements that are necessary to provide continued quality instruction to the students of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Central Valley School Board has voted to place a bond issue on the November 7, 2006, ballot to provide for these necessary improvements to the capital facilities of the District; and


WHEREAS, the Liberty Lake City Council has heard a presentation regarding the need for the capital improvements and received written information explaining the bond measure;

WHEREAS, the Liberty Lake City Council, after having carefully considered the proposed bond measure, finds it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Liberty Lake and to provide necessary capital improvements in a responsible fashion to enhance the education of students within the School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Liberty Lake, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES:




