**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING  
PLACEMENT ON THE BALLOT OF AN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION  
BALLOT PROPOSITION.**

WHEREAS, The City of Liberty Lake is a component city of Spokane County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Departments within the City of Liberty Lake rely on emergency communication systems to help them protect both the citizens and property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington placed an emergency communication ballot proposition on the Fall 2007 general election ballot, which narrowly failed to pass; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County are again putting Resolution 08-0170, Proposition 1 on the ballot to impose an additional one-tenth of zero point one percent sales and use tax as authorized under RCW 82.14.420; and

WHEREAS, the improvement of emergency communications will have a direct positive benefit to the citizens of Liberty Lake as it will enhance the ability of both Police and Fire Departments to provide law enforcement and fire protection services to its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, as follows:


**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Liberty Lake hereby supports Proposition No. 1, Spokane County, Washington "One-tenth of One Percent Sales and Use Tax for Emergency Communications and Facilities to Include Equipment, Crime Check and the Reverse Emergency Notification System."

**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Liberty Lake hereby urges all citizens to vote in the election to be held on May 20, 2008.





**RESOLUTION**

Emacio, Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, did move, second, and unanimously pass a motion approving the following ballot proposition language, subject to further action by the Board in placing the matter before the electors. The ballot proposition language approved was as followed:

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SPOKANE COUNTY ADOPTED RESOLUTION NO. 08-\_\_\_ CONCERNING A PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE SALES AND USE TAX. THE PROPOSITION WOULD IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL ONE-TENTH OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX THROUGHOUT SPOKANE COUNTY FOR A 10 YEAR TIME FRAME, THE PROCEEDS THERE FROM TO BE USED SOLELY FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DESIGN, ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, EQUIPPING, OPERATING, MAINTAINING, REMODELING, REPAIRING, REEQUIPPING, IMPROVEMENT AND FINANCING OF EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS AND FACILITIES TO INCLUDE EQUIPMENT, CRIME CHECK AND THE REVERSE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM.
