

**ORDINANCE NO. 72-A
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 72 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 11, 2001 AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2002 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2002, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR ESTABLISHED POSITIONS".

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the annual budget, it has become necessary to make changes in certain appropriations in order to realize additional criminal justice grant revenues and to provide for funding for additional expenditures for the city police department; and

WHEREAS, the above changes could not reasonable have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance No. 72 was passed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 72; and


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Budget Amendment. The General Fund of the annual budget is amended to provide for new appropriations to realize additional criminal justice grant revenues and to provide for funding for additional expenditures for the city police department. A complete copy of the amended budget is attached to this ordinance as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Effective Date. The Liberty Lake City Council declares that the amendments are effective immediately upon publication of the ordinance.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal laws or regulations, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.
