

**ORDINANCE NO. 107-A
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 107 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 17, 2002 AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2003 THROUGH DECEMBER 2003, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR ESTABLISHED POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the annual budget, it has become necessary to make changes in certain appropriations.

WHEREAS, the above changes could not reasonably have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance No. 107 was passed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 107; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Budget Amendment. The Outlet Trail Fund of the annual budget is amended to provide for new appropriations received from the Transportation Benefit District for construction of a trail; and to provide for funding for construction expenditures for the trail. Outlet Trail Fund (315) is amended as follows:


Section 2. Budget Amendment. The General Fund is amended to transfer \$28,000.00 from unexpended appropriations to Community Development vehicles line item 058.596.64.59.00 for the purchase of two vehicles as set forth in the Department of Planning and Community Development's memorandum dated 7/11/03.

Section 3. Effective Date. The Liberty Lake City Council declares that the amendments are effective five days following publication of the ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal laws or regulations, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

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
