More Choice, More Availability: Zinio Online Magazines

Beginning January 2013, you'll see fewer print magazines in our Reading Room but if you visit our website you'll notice an explosion in content. The library will begin receiving over 20 subscriptions to magazines through the online **Zinio** service provided by Recorded Books, who also give us downloadable audiobooks through OneClick Digital.

Zinio is an interactive, customizable platform full of features and options that deliver full digital versions of the print magazines you want without having to wait for someone else to finish with the new issue. The library will be able to expand its magazine collection and make copies available to everyone at once, resulting in more choice and more access, with no late fees and no returns—you keep whatever you check out! You can set up your own collection and check out as many issues of as many magazines as you want, view magazines and synchronize reading on your mobile device and desktop, cut and print coupons, save and

share articles, download to read off-line when traveling, and receive notifications whenever a new issue is available. We are starting out by moving about half our magazine subscriptions to **Zinio**-only access while keeping some popular and local interest titles in print.

On **Zinio** you'll be able to read titles like *Consumer Reports*, *Eating Well*, *Field and Stream*, *Forbes*, *Men's Health*, *Women's Health*, *Redbook*, *National Geographic Interactive*, *O*, *The Oprah Magazine*, *Popular Science*, and more. Look for Zinio in 2013 and let us know what you think!

Talks with CIN libraries last month resulted in agreement that Liberty Lake's nonresident card holders have full access to physical items in the CIN catalog. No longer will they be limited to items owned by Liberty Lake Municipal Library.

The only exception will be CIN's and Liberty Lake Library's downloadable eBook and audiobook services through Overdrive and OneClick Digital which patrons who live in Spokane County but not within the city limits of Liberty Lake can get free through the Spokane County Library District.
