### GENEALOGY FOR BEGINNERS

Family history is a legacy we can all hand down to posterity but finding out how to uncover that history can convince many that such a task is beyond their abilities. Steve Dahlstrom, a member of the Association of Professional Genealogists, will hold an entertaining one-hour course at the library to demystify that process and set you on the path to telling your family story. The course will focus on defining what family history is, why it is important, and how to get started. After a quick overview of types of research materials available, we will look at a real case with conflicting clues to solve a mystery from the 1800s.


