

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-185
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSAL OF A CERTAIN ASSET ITEM
DEEMED TO BE SURPLUS AND NO LONGER USED BY THE CITY OF LIBERTY
LAKE, WASHINGTON**

WHEREAS, a certain piece of equipment that belongs to the City of Liberty Lake is no longer needed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the equipment is a 2011 Woods Turf Batwing Mower that was included with the purchase of the 2011 Liberty Lake Tractor;

WHEREAS, the City has other equipment that performs better than the 2011 Woods Turf Batwing Mower;

AND WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best public interest to authorize the Mayor or designee to negotiate a fair market sale of the asset as described in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, as follows:

The 2011 Woods Turf Batwing Mower belonging to the City of Liberty Lake as shown in Exhibit A is declared to be surplus to the foreseeable needs of the City and it is deemed to be for the common benefit of the residents of the City to dispose of said asset. The Mayor is authorized to dispose of the items listed in this Resolution in a manner that will be to the best advantage of the City of Liberty Lake.

Summary of Exhibit A:

Surplus item is a 2011 Woods Turf Batwing Mower. Model number is TBW150C.

Originally purchased in 2011 for \$10,326 as one of the attachments to the tractor that was purchased at the same time, the mower has had little use since that time. The City has other mowers in its fleet that performs faster and more efficient. The mower has around 20 hours of use. The vendor has suggested a selling price of \$7500 to \$8000.


