## NEW CHILDREN'S BOOKS

***The Hello Kitty Baking Book*** by Michele Chock—This book is filled with simple recipes and beautiful photography. Check it out and try something yummy!

***Here Be Monsters!*** by Alan Snow —Read the book that inspired the new movie, *Box Trolls*.

***The Madman of Piney Woods*** by Christopher Paul Curtis— Benji and Red may not be friends, but they have something in common. Both of them think they have encountered the strange presence known as The Madman.

***Space Case*** by Stuart Gibbs— Dashiell Gibson, a 12-year-old lunamaut on Moon Base Alpha. He starts unwinding a mystery in the death of the base's top scientist and learns so much more than he bargained for.

***The Time of the Fireflies*** by Kimberley Little—A young girl must unravel a curse put on her family and stop a tragedy from striking the people she loves.

## NEW TEEN BOOKS!

***Afterworlds*** by Scott Westerfeld— A novel-within-a-novel about the parallels between a writer and the heroine of her novel.

***Beetle Boy*** by Margaret Willey—When Charlie was seven, his mother walked out on the family and he is left to console his father by telling silly stories. Years later, these stories still haunt him.

***Crazy*** by Linda Vigen Phillips—Laura lives a typical teenage life growing up in the 1960s, except she carries around the secret of her mother's mental illness. A compelling novel that tackles complex themes.

***Poisoned Apples: Poems for You, My Pretty*** by Christine Heppermann —Poems based on fairy tale characters that explore the way girls think about themselves and others and also how others might perceive them.

***The Young World*** by Chris Weitz—New York's adult population has been wiped out, leaving the young to assemble into tribes. One of these tribes sets out after discovering there might be a cure.





### We Know It Happens...

Library books get torn or wet, Library DVDs & CDs get scratched, broken, or lost. The policy of the Library's Board of Trustees on these issues is listed on our website in the Policy Handbook.

In summary:


1. Items that are lost, broken, or rendered unusable are charged to the patron at the **retail value plus a \$3 processing fee.**
2. The Library **cannot accept** a replacement purchased by a patron. As a city department, the library can only accept payment in lieu of a city-owned item.
3. Damaged items, even if the damage is small, must be repaired by library personnel with appropriate tools and supplies. **Please, do not attempt to repair any library item yourself.**

### A Friendly Reminder About Library Courtesy...

The Library is a no-phone-zone. Please silence your phone while texting and take/make calls in the lobby.



**Children must be closely supervised (within eyesight) and encouraged not to run or use loud voices. Shoes required!**



Crying/loud children should be taken out of the library.

The staff will gladly check out your items for you and bring them out to your car.
