

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-193
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN INVENTORY
ITEMS DEEMED TO BE SURPLUS AND NO LONGER USED BY THE CITY OF
LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON**

WHEREAS, certain police vehicles and other equipment belonging to the City of Liberty Lake is no longer needed by the City; and


WHEREAS, the value and condition of these items of inventory make it impractical to trade the same in on future purchases of new inventory items from the list of assets of the City and to obtain the maximum return for said inventory items, it should be in the best interest of the City to dispose of the items listed in Exhibit A;

AND WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best public interest to transfer both vehicles to a neighboring jurisdiction, to provide speed control within the jurisdiction limits and whereas this jurisdiction does not have adequate funding to provide its own vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, as follows:

The vehicles and other City equipment belonging to the City of Liberty Lake as shown in Exhibit A is declared to be surplus to the foreseeable needs of the City and it is deemed to be for the common benefit of the residents of the City to dispose of said inventory. The Mayor is authorized to dispose of the items listed in this Resolution in a manner that will be to the best advantage of the City of Liberty Lake.


