**Montana in the Park Returns  
Shakespeare to Liberty Lake  
Sat, August 22nd at 5 pm**

*Cyrano de Bergerac*, this year's non-Shakespeare Shakespeare in the Park production, is the swashbuckling & romantic story of an historical figure of 17th century France.



Wikipedia describes *Cyrano de Bergerac*, written in 18797 by Edmond Rostand, as the fictionalized account of a nobleman "in the French Army who is a brash, strong-willed man of many talents. In addition to being a remarkable duelist, he is a gifted, joyful poet and is also shown to be a musician.

However, he has an extremely large nose, which is the reason for his own self-doubt. This doubt prevents him from expressing his love for his distant cousin, the beautiful and intellectual heiress Roxane, as he believes that his ugliness denies him the "dream of being loved by even an ugly woman."

In 1950 actor, José Ferrar won an Academy Award for his portrayal of Cyrano and the play continues to be popular to this day. This version is available from the Library. A modern version, *Roxane*, starring Steve Martin is also available.




