To celebrate, during the week of September 10-15, kids (ages 5 and up) will receive a **free ice cream cone** when they sign-up for a new library card!




New card holders will also be invited to take a picture with their favorite book.*

The Liberty Lake Library offers free cards to residents of Liberty Lake from the age of 5. Because of an agreement with the Spokane County Library District, those outside of our city limits may also have a free library card but one that is limited to physical items here at Liberty Lake or through our CIN consortium of 26 libraries. The same great deal is available to LLML resident cardholders from SCLD. Cards are good for 2 years.

Liberty Lake residents may request items not owned by the CIN consortium through the ILL form on our website, in person, by email (ill@libertylakewa.gov) or by phone. Non-resident card holders must make their requests through their primary library system.

Homeschooling families may get a Home School Card, and private and public school Teachers may get a Classroom Card. A special card for our Homebound patrons is also available. Come to the library or call for more information.


Coming in October —

Phaedra Patrick is the bestselling author of two novels, *THE CURIOUS CHARMS OF ARTHUR PEPPER*, and *RISE AND SHINE, BENEDICT STONE* (known as *WISHES UNDER THE WILLOW TREE* in the UK).

Her first novel, *THE CURIOUS CHARMS OF ARTHUR PEPPER* was translated into over twenty languages worldwide, with film rights optioned in the US. It was awarded the Prix des Lectrices 2017 in France

Sixty-nine-year-old Arthur Pepper lives a simple life. He gets out of bed at precisely 7:30 a.m., just as he did when his wife, Miriam, was alive. He dresses in the same gray slacks and mustard sweater vest, waters his fern, Frederica, and heads out to his garden.

But on the one-year anniversary of Miriam's death, something changes. Sorting through Miriam's possessions, Arthur finds an exquisite gold charm bracelet he's never seen before. What follows is a surprising and unforgettable odyssey that takes Arthur from London to Paris and as far as India in an epic quest to find out the truth about his wife's secret life before they met—a journey that leads him to find hope, healing and self-discovery in the most unexpected places


LIBRARY ETIQUETTE REMINDERS




