

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-029
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
ACQUISITION OF FURNITURE AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT.**

WHEREAS, the policy of the State Washington is to encourage competitive bidding of purchases and supplies by municipalities in order to obtain the lowest responsive bid;

WHEREAS, certain exceptions exist to the above policy for the purchase of equipment including when the purchase involves special facilities or market conditions;

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of acquiring space in order to locate and establish its office for the purpose of conducting the business and affairs of the City;


WHEREAS, in order to properly furnish the City offices, it is necessary to acquire equipment and office furniture;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has exercised diligence in contacting numerous vendors in order to acquire furniture and equipment including the acquisition of the same substantially below the fair market value.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, as follows:

The City Council pursuant to RCW 39.04.280 hereby waives the competitive bidding requirements for the acquisition of office equipment and furniture from Telect, Inc. and Interior Solutions, Inc. due to the acquisition of special facilities and special market conditions. Specifically, the office equipment and furniture is being acquired at substantially below market value as a result of liquidations by the above companies. It is further necessary to acquire the office equipment and furniture at this time in order to properly occupy and use the proposed offices of the City. Through this resolution, the City Council intends to waive the competitive bidding requirements in recognition of the above facts and circumstances.
