RESOLUTION NO.19-251

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS DUE TO A
SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF RASCAL
MVP INFIELD GROOMER

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that based upon research by the Operations and Maintenance Department, the purchase of a Rascal MVP Infield Groomer is appropriate due to the exclusive capabilities of the equipment; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 provides that a local agency, by Resolution, may waive the competitive bidding requirement when the purchase is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply, or when the purchase involves special facilities or market conditions; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is the best interest of the City to purchase the Rascal MVP infield groomer to provide day-to-day maintenance and light renovation work on the ballfields that will meet the City's needs, and thus ABI Attachments, Inc. is the sole source of the equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for and the City Council may waive the competitive bidding requirements for the above reasons; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City of Liberty Lake City Council as follows:

1. The competitive bidding requirement for the Rascal MVP Infield Groomer is waived as this is a sole source purchase, and
2. The City's purchase of the Rascal MVP Infield Groomer developed by ABI Attachments, Inc. is authorized in the amount of \$5,845.82.


