RESOLUTION NO. 19-246

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY RELATING TO THE
CONDITION OF MISSION AVENUE AND WAIVING THE PUBLIC BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS OF RCW 39.04.280**

WHEREAS, Mission Avenue in the City of Liberty Lake ("City") is an arterial street that is utilized by many Liberty Lake citizens and visitors each day for travel within the City; and

WHEREAS, circumstances beyond the control of the City have caused Mission Avenue to sustain damage that presents or could potentially result in damages to property or persons if immediate action is not taken; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that based upon the research of the City Engineer the condition of Mission Avenue between Corrigan Road and Harvest Parkway has deteriorated and will continue to do so as a result of the severe winter conditions; and


WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 and City Policy provide that the City, by Resolution, may waive the competitive bidding requirements when a public works project or purchase is necessitated by an emergency to provide the City the ability to respond and not to compromise the health, safety, or welfare of the people; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency situation does exist and that it is appropriate to waive the competitive bidding requirements for the above reasons and perform necessary repairs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City Liberty Lake City Council the following:


1. Pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(e), an emergency is hereby declared for the above stated reasons to repair Mission Avenue between Corrigan Road and Harvest Parkway.
2. Because the existence of an emergency, the formal bidding requirements set forth in the City of Liberty Lake Financial Policy and Washington law are hereby waived for the purpose of undertaking the repairs.
3. City Staff are hereby authorized and directed to immediately (a) prepare plans and specifications and all other contract documents necessary to undertake the Mission Avenue road repairs, (b) obtain bids from a contractor experienced with such repairs, and the Mayor or designee is authorized to enter into a public works contract with a contractor to perform the Mission Avenue road repair.


