

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-263  
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE  
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENT DUE TO A SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE AND AUTHORIZING THE SERVICES OF MASONRY BRICK WORK ON HARVEST PARKWAY**

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that based upon research by the Finance and Administration Department, the purchase of masonry brick work on Harvest Parkway is appropriate due to the exclusiveness and capabilities of the product; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 provides that a local agency, by Resolution, may waive the competitive bidding requirement when the purchase is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply, or when the purchase involves special facilities or market conditions; and

WHEREAS, this purchase is to replace the damage that was done to the Harvest Parkway Roundabout on October 8, 2019, and R&R Masonry was the contractor that originally constructed the brick wall; and

WHEREAS, the City has been in contact with the insurance company to be reimbursed for all damage to the Harvest Parkway Roundabout; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is the best interest of the City to accept the R&R Masonry bid to repair the damages to the Harvest Parkway Roundabout as a sole source purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is appropriate to waive the competitive bidding requirements for the above reasons; and


NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City of Liberty Lake City Council the following:

1. The competitive bidding requirement for the Masonry Brick Work Agreement is waived as this is a sole source purchase.


