**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE,
WASHINGTON EXPRESSING ITS DESIRE TO WITHDRAW FROM THE
WASHINGTON CITIES INSURANCE AUTHORITY.**

WHEREAS, the City on May 22, 2001 approved Resolution No. 01-006 entitled "A Resolution Authorizing the City of Liberty Lake, Washington to Enter Into An Agreement for Insurance Services and Coverage" with the Washington Cities Insurance Authority;

WHEREAS, the cost of insurance for 2001 was \$2,500.00 with the City recently informed the assessment for 2002 is \$13,884.00;


WHEREAS, the City believes the 2002 insurance cost to be unreasonable based upon the personnel, equipment and potential losses of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of withdrawing from the Washington Cities Insurance Authority and through this resolution makes a request to the executive committee of WCIA.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, as follows:

The City of Liberty Lake, Washington desires to withdraw from the Washington Cities Insurance Authority and requests approval of the same from the WCIA Executive Committee. This request to the Executive Committee is based upon the Interlocal Agreement creating the Washington Cities insurance authority and the authority of the Board to terminate memberships pursuant to Article 17.

Passed by the City Council this 30th day of October 2001.




