

**CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, SPOKANE COUNTY,
WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 20-282**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY RELATING TO THE
CONDITION OF CITY STREETS AND SIDEWALKS AND WAIVING THE
AUTHORIZATION FOR PROCURING SERVICES UNDER THE CITY'S
PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake finds that based upon the research of the Operations and Maintenance Director that the condition of City Streets and Sidewalks from the loss of tree limbs subjected to heavy snows from the October 24, 2020 winter storm created hazardous conditions for drivers and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake has an on-call agreement with Greenleaf Landscaping, Inc. to provide arborist services that includes removal and treatment of damaged tree limbs; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has determined that the cleanup of downed tree limbs in the public right of way is immediately necessary for the safety of the citizens of Liberty Lake; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency situation does exist and that it is appropriate to waive the authorization for procuring services for the reasons set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City of Liberty Lake City Council the following:

1. Pursuant to City of Liberty Lake Financial Policy an emergency is hereby declared for the above stated reasons; and
2. Because of the emergency, contract amount thresholds set forth in the City of Liberty Lake Financial Policy are hereby waived for the purpose of undertaking the necessary work.


