

Holds Pickup Procedure:

1. Request items online or by phone.
2. Receive notification that items are available.
3. Call 509-232-2510 when you arrive in the library parking lot.
4. Have your card ready
5. After you've finished with the phone call, stand behind the holds pickup line on the sidewalk.

Lynda.com will be changing to 'LinkedIn Learning' on March 9.

What does this mean for you?

*Your patron history will migrate to LinkedIn Learning under your existing library card number and PIN.

*You now have access to the entire library of over 16,000 courses. With LyndaLibrary, patrons only had access to 7000 English courses. LinkedIn Learning for Library includes courses in English, French, German, Japanese, Spanish, Mandarin, and Portuguese.

*On the day of your scheduled upgrade, you won't be able to access your Lynda.com profile. Once your upgrade is complete, you can expect a LinkedIn Learning URL from your Library Admin to activate your new account.

* We are working towards ensuring the LinkedIn Learning mobile application will also work for Library patrons. In the meantime, you will be able to explore all of our content through your mobile web browser.
