

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-44
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON REQUESTING
AN ELECTION ON THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY INTO THE CITY OF
LIBERTY LAKE.**

WHEREAS, RCW Chapter 35A.14 authorizes the City Council to call for an election on the question of annexing certain property into the City;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest and the general welfare of the City that the land described on Attachment A be annexed to and become part of the City of Liberty Lake;


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the presently existing land use classifications are the proper and appropriate classifications when the land becomes part of the City with such classifications being industrial and residential properties as further defined by the Spokane County Zoning Code incorporated by reference through City Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City has received petitions for annexation of the two areas described on Attachment "A" which property is located within an urban growth area of Spokane County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington as follows:

The City Council declares its intent to annex the separate areas described on Attachment "A" attached hereto which contains approximately 29 voters residing in the area west of the City limits and 1 voter residing in the area east of the City limits. The City shall pay the cost of the annexation election. Property owners and residents within the area to be annexed will be subject to all laws of the City of Liberty Lake including the proposed zoning regulations and will be taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other similar property in the City and will assume responsibility for all outstanding indebtedness, if any.

The City Clerk-Treasurer is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of County Commissioners and the Spokane County Boundary Review Board. The Spokane Board of County Commissioners is requested to call a special election on the question of annexation in September of 2002, or as soon thereafter as the same may be called following review by the Boundary Review Board. The Planning and Community Development Director is further authorized to prepare and execute all documents necessary and take all reasonable actions to further the purposes and intent of this resolution.
