**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 115 RELATING TO FIREARMS IN
CITY PARKS OR FACILITIES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake passed Ordinance No. 115 regulating the possession of firearms and other related weapons in City Parks and Facilities;

WHEREAS, the regulation of firearms and other related weapons as contained in Ordinance No. 115 conflicts with Washington State law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:


Ordinance No. 115, Section 9 (E) is hereby amended as follows:

The first sentence of Section 9(E), which reads "*No person except duly authorized law enforcement personnel shall possess a firearm, bow and arrow, crossbow, or air or gas weapon or an instrument that projects objects in City Parks or Facilities*" shall be removed and deleted in its entirety.

All other provisions contained in Ordinance No. 115, and as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the date of publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City.




