**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE,  
WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 9 ESTABLISHING CITY  
HOLIDAYS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake adopted a personnel policy in 2002, and subsequent amendments, that addressed City holidays; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 9 may create a conflict with current or future changes to the City's personnel policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.**     Repeal. Ordinance No. 9 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


**Section 2.**     Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

**Section 3.**     Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.


