ORDINANCE NO. 136A**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE,
WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 136 ESTABLISHING THE LIBERTY
LAKE PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE BRIDGE FUND AND FOR PROVIDING FOR OTHER
MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake staff have reviewed Ordinance No. 136 and deemed it no longer of use; and

WHEREAS, the Pedestrian/Bicycle Bridge Fund fulfilled its obligation and is currently a dormant fund; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 136 may create a conflict with subsequent adoptions of the City's annual budget documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance No. 136 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.
