

**ORDINANCE NO. 308C
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 308 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 17, 2024, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2025, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR ESTABLISHED POSITIONS".

WHEREAS, state law provides for the adoption of a budget by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake for the purpose of making appropriations of the total estimated revenues for each separate fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the annual budget, it has become necessary to make changes in the salary schedules within the 2025 annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the following changes could not reasonably have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance 308 was passed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 308; and


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The 2025 Budget is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" which provides for additional staffing included in the 2025 City of Liberty Lake Salary Schedule Summary.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.
