

**ORDINANCE NO. 65-R
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 65 RELATING TO THE
IMPOSITION OF A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF PERMITS FOR
HALFWAY HOUSES AND CRISIS RESIDENTIAL HOUSING, COMMUNITY
TREATMENT FACILITIES, SECURE RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT HOUSING FOR
SEX OFFENDERS OR SIMILAR FACILITIES ESTABLISHMENTS.**

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2001, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 65 which imposed a moratorium on the acceptance of permit applications for residential treatment facilities and declared an emergency;


WHEREAS, the City has had an opportunity to study and review reasonable regulations regarding the above use and has determined it is in the best interest of the City to repeal the above moratorium.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Moratorium. The Liberty Lake City Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 65 entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, Imposing a Moratorium on the Acceptance of Permit Applications for Halfway Houses and Crisis Residential Housing, Community Treatment Facilities, Secure Residential Treatment Housing for Sex Offenders or Similar Facilities Within the City of Liberty Lake and Declaring an Emergency", passed the City Council August 28, 2001 and published on August 29, 2001.


Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of either this Ordinance or the Ordinance Summary.

PASSED by the City Council this 2nd day of October 2001.




