ORDINANCE NO. 116**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON,
ESTABLISHING A GENERAL AND GOLF FUND CHANGE-MAKING ACCOUNT
FOR THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CHANGE
FOR CASH TRANSACTIONS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake is a non charter code city organized and existing under the provisions of Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it to be in the best interest of the City and conducive to the efficient handling of City business to establish a change making account in the City's General Fund and Golf Fund for the purpose of making change for cash transactions.


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. General Fund Change Making Account. The Mayor or designee is hereby authorized to establish a General Fund Cash Account in the amount of \$100.00. This fund is established to facilitate minor authorized cash transactions for the making of change. The fund shall be administered by the Mayor, Finance Director, or designees, in accordance with rules or policies providing for such lawful administration.

Section 2. Golf Fund Change Making Account. The Mayor or designee is hereby authorized to establish a Golf Fund Cash Account in the amount of \$200.00. This fund is established to facilitate minor authorized cash transactions for the making of change. The fund shall be administered by the Mayor, Finance Director, or designees, in accordance with rules or policies providing for such lawful administration.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of the Ordinance in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.


