

**ORDINANCE NO. 195-A
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UTILITY TAX ANNUAL REBATE PROGRAM FOR
THE CITY'S SENIOR AND LOW-INCOME OR DISABLED AND LOW-INCOME
RESIDENTS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake City Council passed Ordinance No. 195, establishing a utility tax rebate program.


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE,
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Ordinance No. 195, Section 2b, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2.

B. Be low-income and age 62 or older at the time an application is made to the City of Liberty Lake for an annual rebate, or totally and permanently disabled and low-income, residing in a separately metered dwelling and who is paying directly for such separately billed service either as owner, purchaser or renter and whose individual area median income is at or below 80% of the median income for the Spokane County area as defined by HUD (Department of Housing and Urban Development).


