

**ORDINANCE NO. 136
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON
ESTABLISHING THE LIBERTY LAKE PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE BRIDGE FUND AND
PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.**

WHEREAS, the City through Ordinance No. 82 has created a Transportation Benefit District for the purpose of developing and maintaining trail systems in, through and around the City of Liberty Lake; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly account for funds and segregate the same from other City funds, it is necessary to establish one separate fund known as the "Pedestrian/Bicycle Bridge Fund" (Fund No. 317).

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:


Section 1. Pedestrian/Bicycle Bridge Fund. There is hereby established a fund to be known as the "Pedestrian/Bicycle Bridge Fund" into which shall be deposited monies received by the City, with expenditures authorized as are properly chargeable to the fund. Monies in the fund shall be used for all purposes consistent with the development and construction of a pedestrian/bicycle bridge. Expenditures include but not limited to the planning, developing and constructing the improvements set forth in the Plan including reasonably related administrative expenses.

Section 2. Accounting. The fund accounting and all expenditures shall be according to rules developed by the State Auditor. Annually, the City during the budget process shall estimate revenues and anticipated appropriations for the above funds.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.


