

**ORDINANCE NO. 165-D
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 165, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 18, 2007 AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ADOPTED ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2008 THROUGH DECEMBER 2008", APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR ESTABLISHED POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2008 annual budget, it has become necessary to make changes in certain appropriations, and to modify salary schedules and titles as funded for in the 2008 budget to accurately recognize organizational changes; and

WHEREAS, the above changes could not reasonably have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance No. 165 was passed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 165; and


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Salary Schedules. Organizational changes made under the new city administration to improve the efficiency and effective delivery of city services are advantageous. The adjustments to the current salary schedule are made within the existing funding limits of the 2008 budget. A copy of the revised schedule, in addition to the salary schedule change as attached as Exhibit "A", and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal laws or regulations, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.
