

**ORDINANCE NO. 144-A  
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE  
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 144 PASSED BY THE CITY  
COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 6, 2005, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF  
LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD  
JANUARY 1, 2006 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2006.**

WHEREAS, state law provides for the adoption of a budget by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake for the purpose making appropriations of the total estimated revenues for each separate fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Annual Budget, it has become necessary to make changes in certain appropriations.

WHEREAS, the following changes could not reasonably have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance 144 was passed by the City Council;

WHEREAS; the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 144; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Budget Amendment. The General Fund is hereby amended to reflect additional expenditure to Project Access in the amount of 2,500 from line item 562.41.00.00 – Community Health.

**Section 2** Budget Amendment. The General Fund is hereby amended to reflect an appropriation of \$3,000 to line item 513.23.41.00 for Professional Services.

**Section 3.** Budget Amendment. City Hall Reconstruction Fund (333) established by Resolution No. 06-87 adopted by the Council on March 7, 2006, is hereby added to the Annual Budget. This fund shall be used and drawn upon for the sole purpose of repair and restoration of City Hall and any other related equipment damaged as a result of a burst pipe on February 18, 2006. This fund shall be used to receive insurance proceeds totaling approximately \$145,000 and said funds shall be used to pay contractors, vendors or any other providers associated with repair and restoration of City Hall.

**Section 4.** Budget Amendment. The General Fund is hereby amended to reflect an operating transfer of \$8350.00 from line item 597.20.00.01 to the City Hall Reconstruction Fund (333), line item 333.595.91.62.03 for fire/sprinkler system improvements.

**Section 5.** Budget Amendment. The Municipal Library Fund (101) is hereby amended to appropriate \$14,000.00 to line item 072.598.21.51.00. Funds will be transferred from the following line-items:

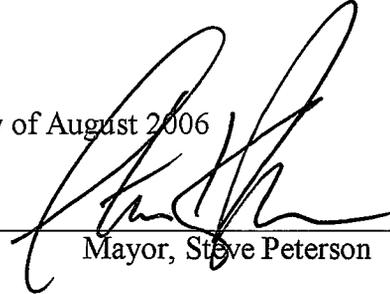

Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

**Section 7. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.

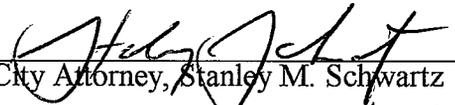
