By now you have settled into a routine at home. School has started. Are you aware of the resources that the Library offers for your students?

- We have the free online tutoring service from Tutor.com available through our website. It is simple: just log on through the Library's website using your library card between 3pm and 10pm daily for help in English, Science, Social Studies, and Math. Live help is there using a protected chat service. Help is available for K-12 as well as college students and adults who have

returned to school or are looking for jobs & career change.

- We offer World Book Online. This is more than an encyclopedia. There are three levels one for adults, one for students and one for kids. Not only are there articles available, but there are also videos and links to more information.
- We offer ProQuest. This online database has magazine, journal, and newspaper articles in full text format. If your students need current articles from the newspaper or a magazine, try this awesome resource. Just log in from the

Library website using your library card number. If you need assistance, call and ask for Tracy or Pamela.

We offer a link to the Quiz List Interactive if your child needs to find a book to read to fulfill reading counts. This link is available from our online catalog.

The Library is full of other resources. Make us your first stop when looking for books/e-information for projects or reports. Use the knowledge of our staff to help you find things quickly and efficiently. We know your time is valuable!

Non-Resident & ILL Policy Changes

Because of the revenue shortfalls of the City of Liberty Lake, the Library Board has reluctantly endorsed changes in how we do Inter-Library Loans and the requirements for free library service.

- If you would like material from another location you will be charged for the postage of \$3.00 for your request. This \$3.00 will be collected when you come to pick up your book. Materials needed for school-related purposes will remain free for students of any age and teachers with appropriate ID.
- ILL items not picked up within 3 days of notification of arrival will be sent back to the loaning library and a \$3.00 postage fee charged to the borrower.
- Current Non-resident card holders who do not allow their cards to expire will not be charged the non-resident fee. Non-resident minor cards will also remain free but with the restriction that the card may only be used for materials that are age appropriate. Cards will also remain free for Idaho residents who have a current
- CIN Library card because of a reciprocal borrowing agreement between Liberty Lake and the CIN Libraries.
- Non-residents will have the option of purchasing an individual card for \$30 or a household card for \$50. Parents of non-resident minors will no longer be required to have a personal card, but their signatures will still be required on their minor's service agreement.

help them sign up. We use SCOPE to deliver the books or Georgette comes personally with her name tag and City ID.

We offer a variety of books including Large Print, Audio books, Movies, and several different types of fiction or non-fiction to fit any readers' tastes.



Children's Holiday Books

It is hard to believe it but the holiday season is just around the corner. The Library offers many books for children about the holiday, its traditions and origins as well as books that have the holiday as its theme. We keep our holiday books in the Children's Room over in the corner in a large blue bookcase. During the Holiday we often feature the books on our display shelves. Normally all of the holiday books may be

checked out for 3 weeks with regular renewals. However, during the holidays we change the check out time of the holiday books so that everyone will get the opportunity to share the books. Starting October 1 the Halloween books will have a check out limit of 3 and will check out for 1 week. These may not be renewed. On November 1 the Halloween books will return to the regular collection and the Thanksgiving

books will have a check out limit of 3 and will check out for 1 week. After Thanksgiving the Christmas books will have a check out limit of 5 and go out for one week. We will have a sign in the Children's Room to remind you of the limits. We hope your family will enjoy the books from our Holiday Collection during the Holiday Season!
