ORDINANCE NO. 214-A**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 214, PASSED ON OCTOBER 7, 2014 ENTITLED, “AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, PROHIBITING MINORS IN CONSUMPTION OF MARIJUANA AND ESTABLISHING ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES THEREOF”

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 214 was passed by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington on October 7, 2014 imposing, among other things, regulations for handling the use of marijuana or marijuana-infused products by minors.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington desires to amend Ordinance No. 214 as set forth herein:

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. City Ordinance No. 214 shall be amended and shall read as follows:

- **Section 1(B):** Minor in Consumption of Marijuana or Marijuana-Infused products is prohibited.

No minor shall be in a public place, or be in a motor vehicle in a public place, while exhibiting the effects of having consumed marijuana or marijuana-infused products. For purposes of this subsection, “exhibiting the effects” of having consumed marijuana or marijuana-infused products means that 1) is in possession of or close proximity to marijuana or marijuana infused products, or 2) by speech, manner, appearance, behavior, lack of coordination, or otherwise, exhibits that he or she has consumed marijuana or marijuana infused products.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.


Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

All other terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 214 shall remain in full force and effect without any further changes.


