

**ORDINANCE NO. 110-A
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 110 RELATING TO STOPPING,
STANDING, PARKING AND IMPOUNDMENT OF UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Liberty Lake passed Ordinance No. 110 adopting rules of the road that relate to stopping, standing, parking and impoundment of unauthorized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, RCW Chapters 35A.46 and 35A.47 grant the City of Liberty Lake the authority regulate and control City streets, including for the safe and efficient movements of pedestrians and vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to amend Ordinance No. 110 to incorporate additional rules to address storage of vehicles on public roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

1. Amendment: Ordinance No. 110 is hereby amended as follows:

- a. Section 1—a new Section 1(D) is to be inserted and which shall read, “*Park and leave standing upon any street, highway, roadway, alley, or any public right of way, including any parking lot owned or controlled by the City, any vehicle, recreational vehicle, trailer, coach, boat or vessel, parts or any other conveyance (collectively “Vehicle”) for a continuous period longer than seventy-two (72) hours unless an extended period of parking is approved by the Chief of Police.*”

If in violation of this section, the police department and/or the City’s code enforcement official(s), after diligent inquiry to locate the owner thereof, may place a notice of infraction on the Vehicle. If the Vehicle has not been removed after a reasonable period of time after the notice of infraction has been placed on the Vehicle, the police department may impound the Vehicle or other property as provided for in this Ordinance or by law.”

The current Section 1(D) shall remain but will be re-titled as Section 1(E).

- b. Section 15—delete the language “*(Provisions 8 thru 14 are Liberty Lake)*” and the “*A*” that follows said language.


All other provisions contained in Ordinance No. 110, and as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any

other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the date of publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City.


