

**ORDINANCE NO. 247D
CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE
SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 247 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 21, 2017, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2018, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR ESTABLISHED POSITIONS".

WHEREAS, state law provides for the adoption of a budget by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake for the purpose of making appropriations of the total estimated revenues for each separate fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the annual budget, it has become necessary to make changes in certain appropriations;

WHEREAS, the following changes could not reasonably have been anticipated or known at the time Ordinance 247 was passed by the City Council;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the best interest of the City is served by amending the adopted budget approved in Ordinance 247;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following accounts contained in the 2018 Budget are hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" which only includes identifying revenue sources and appropriations for the project known as the Harvard Rd Bridge Widening and Improve I-90 westbound.

Section 2. The detail of the amendments is listed in Exhibit "B".

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.


