# Player Development Programs

## Beginner – Trailhead Jrs

In all our camps we recap the basics in a group setting and then give individual attention to all players. This is a fun and informative way to introduce new players to the game. We do try our best to sign up players by ages, but it is not necessary. All equipment is provided if needed.

## Intermediate – Operation 36

A long-term development plan for teaching your beginners to play golf. Following the Operation 36 curriculum, this program centers around playing golf. Juniors will learn different skills while playing games with friends during practice, then testing these skills by playing their first 9 holes. The Op36 Mobile App helps your junior train and track progress. It's also your families guide to playing and practicing outside of classes.



## Advanced – PGA Junior League

Advanced lessons with a little competition. This group has its own curriculum, dates, and times. It is a full summer of golf and set up through the PGA of America. This program is called the PGA Jr League. Contact PGA Professional Troy Smith in the Golf Shop to Sign Up.
