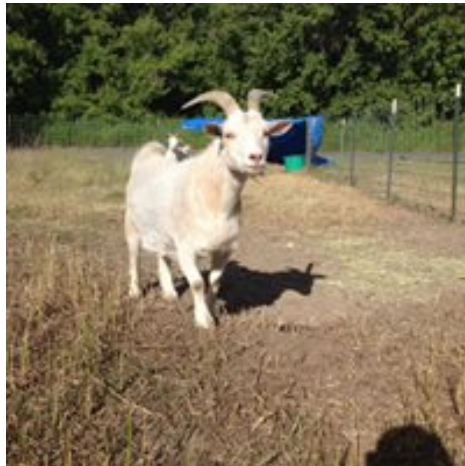
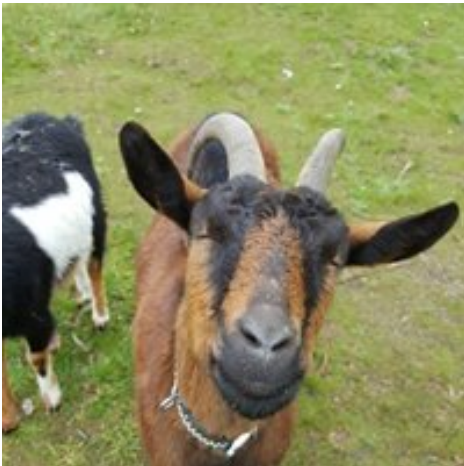
### PROJECT

2019 Goat Statue Installation

### SUBMISSION DEADLINE

April 29, 2019 through May 31, 2019

The Liberty Lake Parks and Arts Commission is accepting submissions for the installation of two (2) life size goat statues or a submission that would fit within the same approximate size parameters, to be installed in Liberty Lake. The following are pictures of the Liberty Lake goats for artist reference of the breed and size of goat that should be represented in the proposal. Additional photos and information is available upon request.



### ARTWORK LOCATIONS

The final location for the statues has yet to be selected. The commission is considering locations at Pavillion Park, Rocky Hill Park, or along the Liberty Lake Trail near Trailhead Golf Course. These are all locations that the goats are regularly housed. Included with this call to artist are some pictures of the Liberty Lake goats in their natural habitats. The artist is encouraged to make an installation location recommendation with their submission.

### ELIGIBILITY

This project is open to all professional and amateur artists and other creative individuals and groups.

## **PROPOSAL**

Public art can promote a sense of community and offer a unique identity for the City of Liberty Lake. It turns ordinary spaces into community landmarks and helps to enrich the quality of life in Liberty Lake. Goats have a long history in Liberty Lake. The statues will be installed in public spaces and the artist should plan for the public to interact with the statues.

Sculptures shall be safe, appropriate for all audiences and durable. All submitted works shall be constructed from materials that withstand constant exposure to weather elements and temperature variances typical of the area. The works will be displayed in an unprotected public forum, so all submitted works shall be structurally sound enough to withstand handling, touching, and possible physical stress. All sculptures shall be in 'intended condition' when delivered. Where applicable, material shall be sealed, repainted, or other appropriate measures taken to protect the structure surface.

## **INSTALLATION**

Sculptures shall be delivered with a steel (preferred) or stainless steel base on the bottom, a minimum of half inch (1/2") larger than the sculpture at the base. This will allow for welding the sculpture(s) to a pedestal for a more secure installation. Other methods may be recommended by the artist.

## **SCULPTURE REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION DETAILS**

Artists are invited to submit up to four (4) files for consideration. Artists may submit photos and/or sketches of the proposed piece.

The submitted artwork may be a new or existing piece created by the artists. Submitted designs must be original works of the artist and in compliance with all existing copyright laws. Due to the public nature of the project, artwork shall not contain advertising, religious art, sexual, violent or other content unsuitable for all ages and cannot convey political partisanship.

The Liberty Lake Parks and Arts Commission selection criteria will include, but not be limited to: artist quality, content, and diversity. Artists will be notified by July 31, 2019.

## **File Submission**

Artist shall include the artist statement detailed in this document with submissions. Each submission shall include the following information:

Price

Physical Dimensions (width, depth, height, and weight)

**Image Title:** All submissions shall be titled. File format shall be as follows: lastname.firstname.title
