Make Sure We Stop for You

- Some tips to make sure you get noticed:
- Stand visibly at the stop as the bus approaches.
 - Face the bus and nod your head "yes" c
 - wave to the driver.
 - Hold up your pass.
 - Step forward when the bus is 1/2 block away.
 - Wear light colored clothing or use a flashlight or the light of a cellphone at night to signal the driver.
 - If you're in a shelter, walk to the stop as the bus approaches.
- stop at the next bus stop.
- If you don't know which stop you need, ask the driver for help. When you are one block away from your stop, pull the overhead bell cord to signal the driver.
 - As you board, ask the driver for a 2-ho
 - pass (transfer) if you need one.

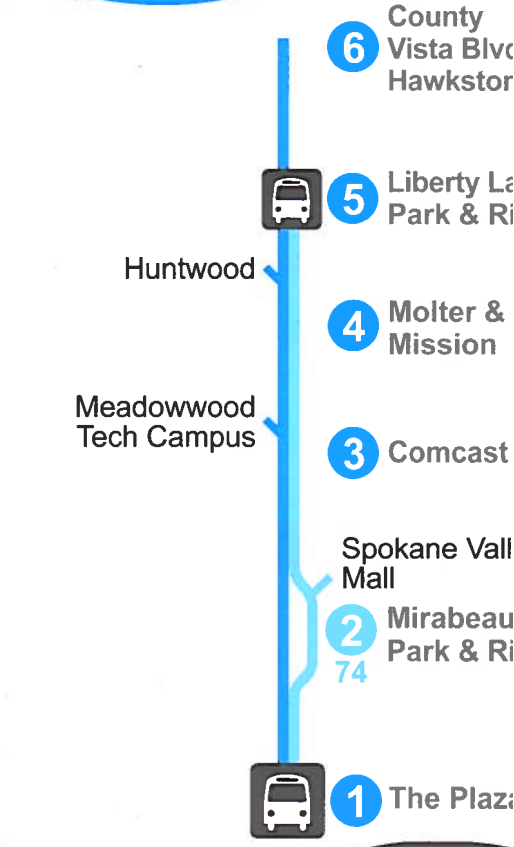

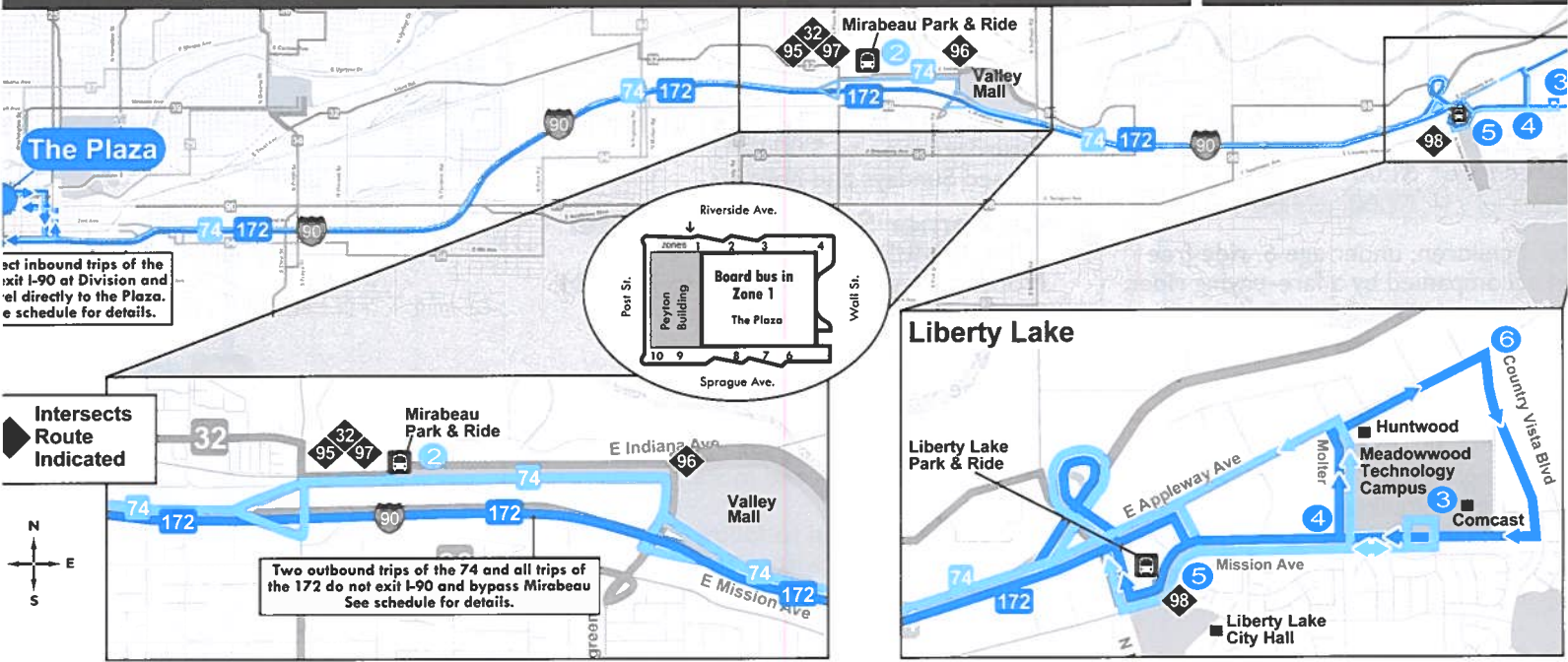
