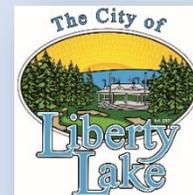

On August 31, 2001, the City of Liberty Lake was incorporated and was home to over 4,000 residents. Twenty years later, our community has blossomed into a beautiful city of over 12,000 residents. Our community is home to various businesses and sources of entertainment and fun. Just after incorporation, the Liberty Lake Police Department was formed to provide law enforcement services for the citizens and businesses in the city. Just as the city bloomed, so did the Liberty Lake Police Department. Today, the Liberty Lake Police Department employs 18 fully commissioned law enforcement officers, two administrative personnel, and two volunteers.

# Sir Robert Peels Principals of Policing

Sir Robert Peel, who established the London Metropolitan Police Force in 1829, is considered the “Father of Modern-Day Policing.” With the assistance of his commissioners, Sir Peel developed a list of nine (9) policing principles that are as important today as they were at the time of their development. The 9 Policing Principles are reflected in the Liberty Lake Police Department vision statement, mission statement, and core values.



## 9 Policing Principles

1. The basic mission for which the police exist is to prevent crime and disorder.
2. The ability of the police to perform their duties is dependent upon public approval of police actions.
3. Police must secure the willing co-operation of the public in voluntary observance of the law to be able to secure and maintain the respect of the public.
4. The degree of co-operation of the public that can be secured diminishes proportionately to the necessity of the use of physical force.
5. Police seek and preserve public favour not by pandering to public opinion but by constantly demonstrating absolute impartial service to the law.
6. Police use physical force to the extent necessary to secure observance of the law or to restore order only when the exercise of persuasion, advice and warning is found to be insufficient.
7. Police, at all times, should maintain a relationship with the public that gives reality to the historic tradition that the police are the public and the public are the police; the police being only members of the public who are paid to give full-time attention to duties which are incumbent on every citizen in the interests of community welfare and existence.
8. Police should always direct their action strictly towards their functions and never appear to usurp the powers of the judiciary.
9. The test of police efficiency is the absence of crime and disorder not the visible evidence of police action in dealing with it.

# The Six Pillars of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing

In 2016, the President’s Task Force on 21st Century Policing was established to guide best practices to law enforcement agencies in the United States. The overall goal of the task force was to develop strategies that would build and increase public trust while, at the same time, promote effective crime prevention and reduction strategies. The result of the task force examination resulted in a published 116-page final report of observations and recommendations for law enforcement agencies. The observations and recommendations were categorized into six (6) themes called pillars:

1. Building Trust and Legitimacy
2. Policy and Oversight
3. Technology and Social Media
4. Community Policing and Crime Reduction
5. Officer Training and Education
6. Officer Safety and Wellness



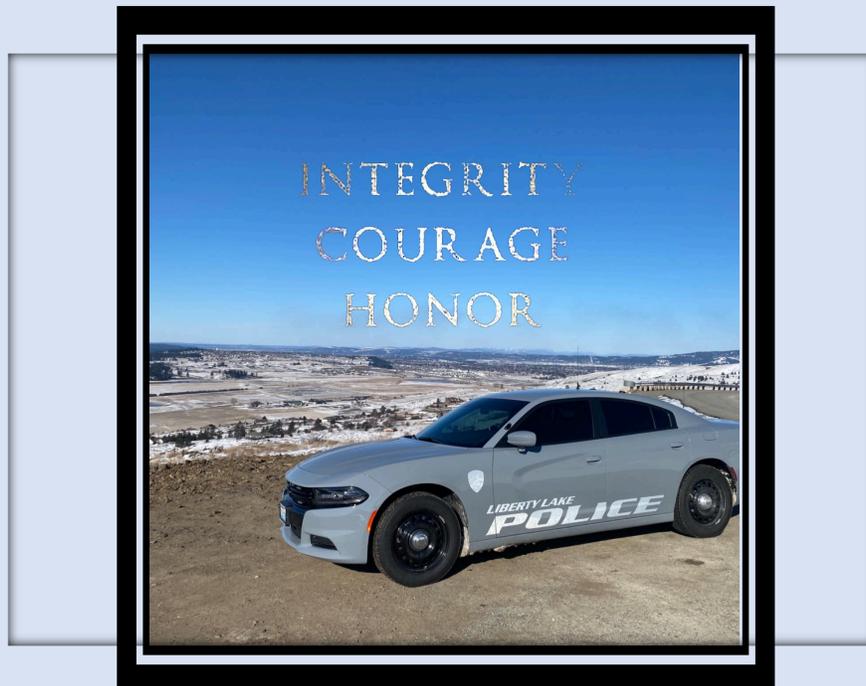

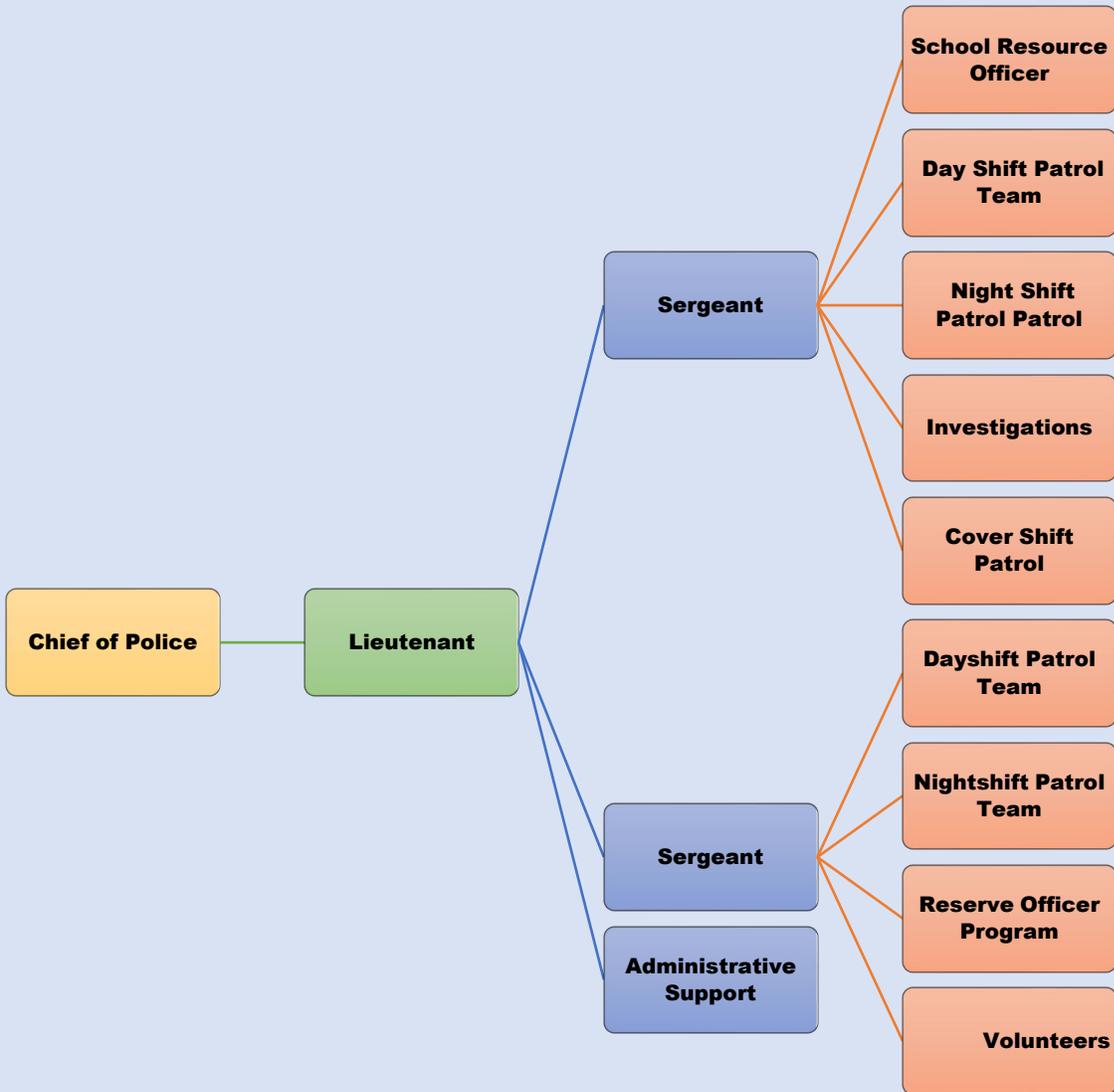

# Liberty Lake Police Department Divisions, Specialties, and Volunteers

## Administrative Division

The Administrative Division consists of the Chief of Police, Lieutenant, and two Police Records Clerks. The staff in the Administrative Division oversee the general operations of the agency and is responsible for operational tasks such as administering the agency's budget, purchasing, hiring, and expenditure tracking.

## Detectives

The Liberty Lake Police Department has two Detectives responsible for follow-up investigation of actual or suspected felonies and misdemeanors, crime scene investigation and processing, and other investigative duties.

## School Resource Officer

Liberty Lake is home to Ridgeline High School, Selkirk Middle School, Liberty Lake Elementary, and Liberty Creek Elementary, all part of the Central Valley School District. The safety and security of the students, staff, and parents at each educational institution in the City of Liberty Lake is important. The Liberty Lake Police Department provides an officer to serve as the School Resource Officer at Ridgeline High School, Selkirk Middle School, Liberty Lake Elementary, and Liberty Creek Elementary. This position is partially funded by the school district to assist the district's administrators and security staff with securing the safety and security of the school's assets.



## Patrol Division

The "backbone" of the Liberty Lake Police Department is the patrol division. The Patrol Division consists of 11 fully commissioned law enforcement officers. These officers provide 24 hours a day, 365 days a year policing services to the citizens, businesses, and other resources and entities in the City of Liberty Lake. In addition to the services these officers provide within the city limits of Liberty Lake, they also serve as an additional resource for surrounding law enforcement agencies during critical incidents and emergencies in their jurisdictions.

## Reserve Officer Program

The purpose of the Reserve Police Officer program at the Liberty Lake Police Department is to provide the Patrol Division with additional routine, emergency, and special event staffing. The Reserve Officer program at the Liberty Lake Police Department consists of officers who have attained a reserve officer or commissioned officer certification by the State of Washington Criminal Justice Training Commission.

## Volunteer Program

One of the most important and appreciated resources at the Liberty Lake Police



Department are the individuals who volunteer their services to the agency and the community. Volunteers at the Liberty Lake Police Department include a Police Chaplain and a Police Ambassador. Our agency's Police Chaplain provides spiritual and psychological support to officers and our community during routine and difficult times and our Police Ambassador serves as our community and law enforcement support liaison. Our Chaplain and Police Ambassador

work with together to serve both the agency and community.

## Spokane Regional Air Support Unit Tactical Flight Officer

The Spokane Regional Air Support Unit provides valuable search and rescue, fugitive searching, fire suppression, surveillance, homeland security critical infrastructure checks, natural disaster damage assessment, and patrol services to the Inland Northwest. Tactical Flight Officers are comprised of deputies and police officers from the Spokane County Sheriff's Office, Kootenai County Sheriff's Department, Spokane Valley Police Department, Coeur d'Alene Police Department, Spokane Police Department, and an officer from the Liberty Lake Police Department.

# Liberty Lake Police Department Strategic Plan Purpose, Process, and Implementation



## I. Purpose

The Liberty Lake Police Department's 2022-2026 Strategic Plan is a proactive tool that provides guidance in fulfilling our agency's mission with maximum efficiency and impact. The purpose of the Strategic Plan is to provide direction and continuity for the Liberty Lake Police Department to improve its service to the citizens of Liberty Lake. The goals derived during the strategic analysis are broad, measurable categories that will have a

responsible party or parties assigned to them, and when achieved, move the organization closer to its stated vision. Under each goal are objectives that more clearly define the intent of the strategic goal. Objectives set specific measurable targets for each goal, and they are adaptable and can change over time. Each objective will have action items. The action items are specific activities that need to be completed to accomplish the objective and may involve multiple initiatives or projects. The number of objectives and action items will vary depending upon the strategic goal.

The guiding principles of, and all efforts in, this Strategic Plan will be:

- Accomplished with a high degree of professionalism.
- Encompassing of the Department's mission, vision, and values.
- Considerate and open to potential partnerships to maximize resources, avoid duplication of services, and improve service to the community.
- Designed and implemented with consideration to best practices.
- Inclusive of all stakeholders and considerate of their input.
- Thoroughly planned and reviewed by stakeholders before implementation.
- Benchmark for progress within our agency and a system of accountability.
- Evaluated and reported on an annual basis.

## II. Planning Process

### A. Review of 2018-2022 Strategic Plan

The 2018-2022 Liberty Lake Police Department Strategic Plan was created and authored by Retired Chief of Police Brian Asmus. Chief Asmus identified six strategic goals during his strategic analysis.

Goal #1 – Staffing: Meet the long and short-term staffing needs.

Goal #2 – Budgeting: Ensure continued financial sustainability.

Goal #3 – Training: Ensure professional growth and motivation of employees.

Goal #4 – Technology: Utilize technology to improve efficiency.

Goal #5 – Marketing: Understand, create, communicate, and deliver services to the community by way of proactive public information.

Goal #6 – Capital Projects/Fleet Rotation Plan: Identify capital projects and update the vehicle rotation plan.

Chief Asmus built upon these goals and worked towards successful completion during that five-year period. Chief Asmus retired before a formal evaluation of his plan. The 2018-2022 plan will serve as the foundation to continue the Strategic Planning process for 2022-2026.

### B. Stakeholder Input

#### i. Community Input

The views and opinions of the citizens of Liberty Lake are vital to the long-term success of our organization. Due to the impact of COVID-19 during the planning, drafting, and implementation of this Strategic Plan, we were unable to safely plan an effective external stakeholder meeting to gather community input. As documented later in this document, community input is one of the goals of this Strategic Plan. Social media is a powerful tool. The Liberty Lake Police Department has over 5000 follows on social media (Facebook). The comments, concerns, and input from citizens were considered while developing this Strategic Plan.

#### ii. Employee Input

The purpose of gaining employee input in this Strategic Plan was to identify our organization's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and potential future adversities. Officers and support staff of the Liberty Lake Police Department were asked to complete a mixed-methods survey obtained from the International Association of Chiefs of Police. The survey consisted of four sections:

1. The Community
2. The Department
3. Demographics
4. Comments

The total sample size for the survey was 16 ( $n=16$ ). Officers and/or staff completed the survey. Volunteers did not participate in this survey. In addition to the survey, Chief Damon Simmons also had a “one on one” with each employee in the agency to discuss strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. The most common themes were derived from the survey and personal discussions.

Our five-year plan will be evaluated and updated annually by gathering input from employees, partners, and community members. Each of the objective action items will be assigned a responsible party, a timeline for completion, and a funding source (see acronym legend below). Limited resources demand that the department focus its energy and direction on these strategic directions for maximum efficiency in meeting our mission. This plan does not cover everything that needs to be accomplished within the agency but instead places focus on priority areas. For the Strategic Plan to succeed, it requires a full commitment, participation, and input from all members of the agency. The goals and objectives of the Strategic Plan will be communicated to all Liberty Lake Police Department members.
