### Who can participate?

City of Liberty Lake residents who subscribe to WM collection services.

### How do I participate?

Simple! Bring this flyer and approved items to the event location.

### How many trips are allowed?

- 1 trip for Clean Green
- 1 trip for Bulky Waste

### Do I have to help unload?

Yes, please come prepared to remove items from your vehicle.

For the quickest and easiest trip, please place a tarp under any yard debris for easy unloading.

### Are loaded trailers OK?

No, trailers and moving trucks are prohibited. Materials must fit in a standard pickup truck bed.

### Can I bring bags of garbage?

Please use curbside service for household garbage that can fit in bags. Only items too large to fit in a bag are accepted at this event.
