

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Purpose

The City of Liberty Lake’s Community Satisfaction Survey is designed to measure resident sentiment across a range of priorities and results expressed in the 2024-2028 Strategic Plan, which is available to view and download on the city’s website at <https://www.libertylakewa.gov/496/Strategic-Plan>. Surveys are planned each January between 2024 and 2028 so that city leaders can evaluate changing sentiments over time and use the results to improve the quality of core services, better align the city budget with its strategic priorities, and help the community realize the key results in the strategic plan.




